

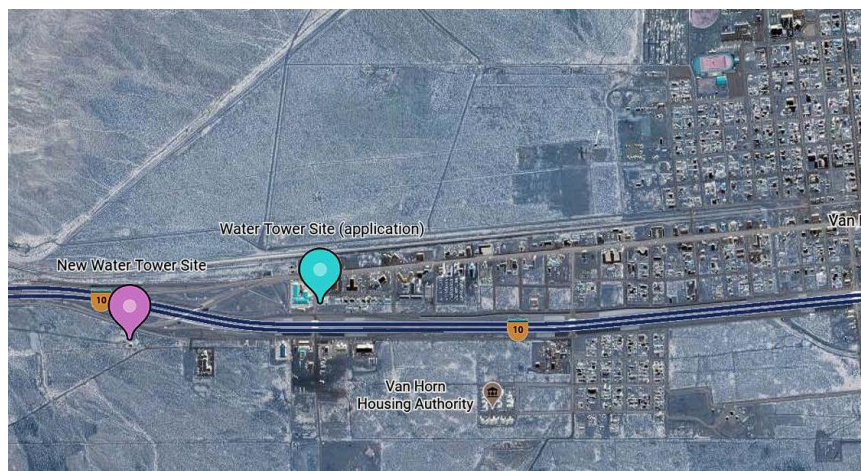

PUBLIC NOTICE

The U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration (EDA) is considering a request for Federal assistance from the Town of Van Horn to construct the Third Water Pressure Zone Project in Van Horn, Culberson County, Texas. Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), EDA is assessing the potential for the proposed project to affect the environment and/or historic properties.

The project involves constructing a 100,000-gallon elevated water storage tank and connecting water lines, pump station, and appurtenances necessary to meet applicable water pressure regulations. The water storage tank will be located on the southwest portion of Van Horn from the frontage road from I-10 E, mile marker 138, approximately 1,381 feet from the exit. Water lines and appurtenances will be placed along W Frontage Road, Golf Course Drive, and W Broadway Street using existing street rights of way.
